Dear Sir.

It is submitted that as per the feedback received from the above stakeholders and analysis done by the undersigned the following points are hereby submitted for your kind consideration regarding the syllabi of UG courses taught in the college:

- The Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) provides an opportunity for the students to choose courses from the prescribed courses comprising core, elective/minor or skill-based courses. All the stakeholders are urging to adopt the CBCS system in all UG courses from the coming session i.e., 2021-2022 so that the flexibility and effectivity of the programmes can be increased.
- As per the feedback of employers, the syllabi of main professional courses like BCA/E.Sc. Non-Medical with Computer Science are pretty old and not industry oriented, so if a student pursue his/her career in software industry after his/her graduation, he/she is not a good fit with current knowledge. Hence the syllabi of these courses néed updation in terms of courses and course contents as per the current industry needs.
- As per the feedback of the faculty, in programmes, students come from different backgrounds, hence there is a need of add-on/bridge courses to have the balance in the classroom for example, communication skills, personality enhancement, fundamentals of programming, Basics of documents/spreadsheets etc. So, you are requested to allow some bridge courses for students to be run by the college.

- Also, as per the feedbacks of the faculty, the focus of curriculum needs to be more practical oriented to match the needs of industry and real-life scenario, so there is a need to include more practical aspects for the students.
- As per the feedback of Students/Alumni/Faculty, the courses of a programme must include experiential learning through project work/field work/internship/onthe-job-training etc. to have the working exposure of industry to the students.

So, you are hereby requested to consider the above points in UGBOS and take necessary actions regarding the same.

Dear Madam/Sir

This letter is in reference to the suggestions to be tendered before the UGBOS in concern to the syllabus review and updation on the basis of feedback taken from the faculty, students and alumni of the Department of Zoology, Sanatan Dharma College, Ambala Cantt. The college involved regular and former students in a feedback drive in the form of questionnaire to understand and explore suggestions on refinement and coherence in the existing syllabus of Zoology as the job market, advanced education and research field are becoming demanding and challenging which require deft and skilled incumbents. Following suggestions are proposed before UGBOS, based on the conscientious perusal of feedback:

Choice Based Credit System allows the flexibility in education system so that students depending upon their interests and aims can choose interdisciplinary, intra-disciplinary and skill-based courses from a list of prescribed courses. The faculty and the students' feedback strongly urge the university to adopt CBCS from the session 2021-22 so that the flexibility and impact of the programmes can be increased.

Animal Behaviour is an important aspect of animal science, however, the present syllabus does not include the detailed study of different topics under 2.

animal behaviour, so it is suggested to add the same.

Wild Life Biology is an emerging subject so it should be made a part of syllabus. Various topics like wildlife, threats, and conservation, remote 3. sensing, GIS should be added to upgrade the Ecology Syllabus. Photography and Photo editing topics should be included in the practicals.

- Aquaculture and Pest Management are the only topics of economic zoology and that too are limited to maximum theoretical part. Some more practicals should be added to enhance the hands on skills related to these topics.
- The field experience creates different types of professionals in the field of 5. Zoology such as in research and development, conservationist, ecologist, taxonomist and environmental consultant. Therefore, field-based studies and a project report should be made mandatory in the curriculum.

6. The Question Paper should be designed in a way that choice of questions be reduced for the academic excellence and also to avoid the selective approach

of students in studying the curriculum.

7. There should be a provision for choice-based internship in industry and research establishments in the 5th or 6th semester for the students who wish to pursue post-graduation and research in Zoology.

8. There should be a provision to provide the students of Bachelor's programme in Zoology, an opportunity to opt one or more courses in allied disciplines to help them pursue specialization/research in interdisciplinary areas, for example, computers, statistics, and mathematics.

You are requested to consider the above suggestions in the meeting of UGBOS and take necessary actions.

Dear Madam/Sir

We are writing concerning the syllabus review and updating based on the feedback taken from the faculty, students and alumni of the Department of Botany, Sanatan Dharma College, Ambala Cantt. The college took the feedback of regular and former students in the form of a questionnaire to seek the relevance and suggestions for improvement of the existing undergraduate syllabus of Botany given the demand of job market, higher education, research and various competitive examination. After the careful analysis of the feedback and the brainstorming session of the faculty members, the following suggestions are being proposed to UGBOS for consideration.

- 1. Choice Based Credit System opens pathways for several learning opportunities as the student has the flexibility to choose their course from a list of elective, core, and soft skill courses. The faculty and the students' feedback urge the university to adopt CBCS from the session 2021-22.
- 2. Plant Pathology is an important aspect of plant science and has tremendous scope in research, however, the present syllabus does not include the introduction of any concept of phytopathology. Terms and concepts; general symptoms; geographical distribution of diseases; etiology; host-pathogen relationships; disease cycle and, prevention and control of common plant diseases, namely, Rusts and Smuts of Wheat, TMV, Red Rot of Sugarcane, and Early and Late Blights of Potato be introduced to the students.
- 3. Classification of plant groups based on APG IV system be introduced.
- 4. The Question Paper should be divided into compulsory four units instead of two for academic excellence and also to avoid the selective approach of students in studying the curriculum.
- 5. The field experience creates different types of professionals in the field of

Botany such as in research and development, conservationist, plant explorer, ecologist, horticulturist, plant biochemist, nursery manager, plant pathologist, taxonomist, farming consultant and environmental consultant. Therefore, field-based studies and a project report should be mandatory in the curriculum.

6. There should be a provision for choice-based internship in industry, and research establishments in the 5th or 6th semester for the students who wish

to pursue post-graduation and research in Botany.

7. There should be a provision to provide the students of Bachelor's programme in Botany, an opportunity to opt one or more courses in allied disciplines to help them pursue specialization/research in interdisciplinary areas, for example, computers, statistics, and mathematics.
