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





- Curriculum inculcates an insight to develop interest in the subject area.
- The internal assessment system as prescribed by the university is fair and unbiased.
- The Design of curriculum in terms of extra learning or self-learning is helpful.

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Question wise Analysis of Responses received from Students of Arts, Science & Commerce

Q-1 The size of syllabus in terms of load on the students is good.

- ❖ 100% Arts students think that the size of the syllabus in terms of Load on students is good and can be covered in the prescribed time of the semester.
- \$ 87% students of Science agreed that the size of syllabus is optimum and extra load is not there on the students. Only 2 % students think that load is high in terms of syllabus.
- ❖ 72% students agreed that the size of syllabus is optimum and extra load is not there on the students. 20 % students think that load is high in terms of syllabus. Department of Commerce will make an action plan to address the suggestions by the organizing extra lectures in next session in terms of organizing extra lectures to cover the syllabus.

Q2 Objectives stated to the course contents are relevant.

- ❖ 85% of the Arts students provided the consent on the objective mentioned in the curriculum. No major changes are required in this aspect.
- * 84% of the students state that objectives mentioned in the curriculum are relevant and 3 % student think that objectives of the course can be more elaborated.
- * 80 % of the Commerce students state that objectives mentioned in the curriculum is relevant and the objectives are clearly stated. No disagreement was found.

Q3 Curriculum has good balance between theory and practical.

- 77% responses of Arts students show that there is a good balance between theory and practical.
 No disagreement was noticed. No major changes are required to implement in this aspect
- * 77% responses of science students show that there is a good balance between theory and practical. Only 2 % students show their disagreement on this. No major changes are required to implement in this aspect.
- 77 % responses from Commerce students show that there is a good balance between theory and practical. 7 % students think that more practical aspects can be added to have a good balance between theory and practical.

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Q4 The contact hours mentioned in the syllabus are sufficient to complete the syllabus in time.

* 85% Arts students are satisfied and 7% mentioned that the contact hours are less. It has been

decided by the Arts Faculty to arrange Extra Classes as per the demand if the syllabus is not

complete in time.

* There is sufficient time provided by the university in terms of teaching period to complete the

syllabus of all science subject areas.71% students agreed and 11% of science students

mentioned that the contact hours are less.

Only 56% of the Commerce students seem satisfied in terms of teaching period to complete the

syllabus all science subject areas. 8% of commerce students mentioned that the contact hours

are less. Remaining is neutral on this response.

major changes are suggested.

❖ 100% of the Arts students are satisfied with the internal assessment system. Institute also uses

ERP system where students are able to access their internal assessment of each subject in their

ERP account after each Semester

❖ 72% of the students of Science are satisfied with the internal assessment system. 8 % students

are not satisfied and have shown their disagreement.

❖ 64% of the Commerce students are satisfied with the internal assessment system. No

disagreement found.

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Q7 Curriculum related reading material is available in library.

- ❖ 73% Arts students are satisfied with the availability of the books and Reading Materials in the Central Library. No disagreement on this point was noticed.
- ❖ 74% Science students are satisfied with the availability of the books and reading materials in the Central Library. 8% students say that there must be more number of books and reading material.
- ❖ 88% Commerce students are satisfied with the availability of the books and Reading Materials in the Central Library. Only 4 % students say that there must be number books and reading material that must be added.

- ❖ 80% of the students of Commerce are satisfied with the curriculum in terms of scope of employability where as only 4 % students do feel that there is a scope of

Q9 The Design of curriculum in terms of extra learning or self-learning is helpful.

- 77% of the Arts students are satisfied but 15 % students did not agree.
- ❖ 78% of the Science students are satisfied. 4 % students did not agree at this point.
- ❖ 64% of the commerce students are satisfied. 36% students are neutral on this aspect and no disagreement was noticed

Q10 Curriculum creates opportunity to the students in gaining knowledge and skills.

- * 88% of the Arts students agree that the syllabi create opportunities to gain knowledge and skills but 8% students did not agree and think that there is a scope of improvement in this context.
- ❖ 79% of the Science students agree that the syllabi create opportunities to gain knowledge and skills. 4% students did not agree on this aspect and suggested that there is scope of improvement.
- * 88 % of the Commerce students are satisfied on the enrichment of syllabi to create the opportunities for the students in gaining knowledge and skills. 8% students are not agreed on this aspect and scope of improvements in this context has been noticed.

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Students Feedback Analysis – Question No: 11(Part-B)

Part-B analysis is based on the suggestions asked from the students in the feedback form. The analysis has been done Department wise and Action has been planned accordingly.

Following is the descriptive analysis of the feedback back collected:

Department of Physics:

- The students of B.Sc. first year suggested that one science project must be included in every semester.
- > B.SC second year suggested that some articles of optics can be deleted from paper Computer Programming and Thermodynamic.
- > Students of B.Sc final year suggested addition of Particle Physics in paper of Nuclear Physics.
- The students of M.SC final year were of the view that the syllabus of Condensed Matter Physics must be in a systematic pattern.

Department of Computer Science:

- The students suggested new Technologies like Python, Digital Marketing, Search Engine Optimization Techniques, Wordpress must be added in the syllabus
- It was highlighted by the Computer Science students that some subjects like MIS, Maths in the syllabus are not relevant to the curriculum.
- > Syllabus should be updated regularly according to the trends and need of the market.
- Include Practicals of subjects like Software and Artificial Intelligence.
- There must be internship in the last semester of Final Year Students.

Department of Electronics & IT

- The students of Electronics suggested that along with the practicals, the Python language must be added to the curriculum so that they may be compatible to the market requirements.
- It was also suggested to shift Digital Electronics-I subject from Semester-I to Semester-II so as to make continuity of the subject of Digital Electronics with the proceeding semesters.
- Industrial training after each session was suggested by the students as per the demand of the present scenario.

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The students of B.Sc (Hons) –IT recommended PHP and Java training course to be covered along with the university curriculum.

It was also suggested that subject related more workshops must be conducted so as more hands-on exposure can be experienced by the students.

Department of Commerce:

Some B.Com, M.Com, and BBA students contributed their thoughts to assist and emphasize the basic notion for a better understanding.

The students of B.Com and BBA suggested that practical knowledge, interview skills, tally, law, Tax and language (English/ Hindi) should be given more importance in the curriculum.

M.Com students suggested including research methodology as a part of the curriculum.

Department of Political Science:

Some students added suggestions to make the syllabus compatible with the market and job requirements.

It was demanded that communication skills should be included to improve the personality and also efforts to be made at the institute level to make students ready for the market requirements by adding new content in terms of bridge courses and certificate courses.

Department of Mathematics:

The students of B.Sc. 1styear added suggestions to provide remedial lectures for allowing the clear concepts of Solid Geometry.

They also suggested a bridge course to connect concepts of number theory with the competitive level questions of reasoning.

Students of M.Sc. Maths suggested that there should be more practical classes or some add on course on MATLAB.

Students suggested that with regular classes there should be lectures on the preparations of UGC CSIR NET.

B.A./B.Sc. 3rd year students suggested that the paper Groups and Rings should be more theoretical and less numerical and also suggested for bridge course to connect the concepts of Physics with Dynamics.

Department of English:

> Students of English (BA/BA Hons/M.A)added some suggestions in order to make the syllabus compatible with the market and job requirements.

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It was proposed that skill enhancement and communication skills extension lectures should be included to improve the personality

Department of Home Science:

- > The students of B.Sc- Home Science suggested to inculcate the skills of Bakery items making, Managerial Skills.
- > The development about the communication skills, Fine Arts workshops and Seminars were also suggested.

Department of Hindi:

- ✓ Some of the students of BA Final year added suggestions in order to strengthen the basic concept so that they can understand the language and Literature better.
- ✓ The students suggested that the curriculum should be related to grammar and pronunciation.
- ✓ Some students suggested including Prayojanmulak Hindi (Functional Hindi) in the textbooks so that the employment opportunities can be made available to the students.

Overall Remarks: The feedback received from the students about the current curriculum is overall satisfactory. The suggestions given by the students are considered and efforts will be made to fulfill all the suggestions and requirements of the students regarding curriculum.

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Remarks: The overall response of the questions given by Teachers of Various Department is inclined between 4 and 5, which signifies the satisfactory results about the curriculum provided by the university. For updation requirements of the curriculum as suggested by the teachers, Various courses and training programs may be organized so that students may be skilled as per the market requirements.

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Teachers Feedback Analysis (Question-10) (Part-B)

Part-B analysis is based on the suggestions given by Teachers of various Departments. The analysis has been done Department wise and Action has been planned accordingly. The descriptive analysis of the feedback back collected is as follows:

Department of Physics:

The Teachers are somewhat satisfied with the curriculum and suggested that in B.Sc (1st sem) Paper-Electricity, Magnetism and EM theory some examples related to displacement current may be added so that students may be benefitted by having an in-depth knowledge of the subject.

Department of Computer Science:

- It was found that few contents in the final year are out dated and may be replaced by new technology.
- > It was also suggested that latest languages like PHP, Python and Project Work must be added in the curriculum of BCA, B.Voc and B.Sc Computer Science.
- > It was also suggested that as it is a professional course so industrial training must also be provided to the students.
- > FDP should be conducted time to time for the enhancements of the skills of the faculty members in new subjects like Software Testing, ASP.NET, PHP and Cloud Computing.

Department of Electronics & IT

- > Electronics and IT teachers partially agreed with the curriculum.
- It was suggested that the paper-II of semester-I & II must be swapped so as to make the continuity in the learning of the digital Electronics subject.
- > It was also suggested that there is requirements of more workshops for the subject of the electronics so as to make the students ready for the industry.

Department of Commerce and Management:

Teachers are generally pleased with the program and advised a number of strategies to aid students. It was indicated that some fundamental, communication and skill enhancement courses must be made available for the students.

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Department of Political Science:

- > It was suggested that a more advanced topic should be added to the syllabus and there should be more focus on practical knowledge for the ability improvements of the students.
- > It was also suggested that students should get exposure to industry by means of internships.

Department of Mathematics:

- ➤ It was found that syllabus of M.Sc. Mathematics classes is lengthy in terms of number of theorems. So, syllabus of both the years i.e., M.Sc. 1st& 2nd Years should be revised. There is a need to provide seminars & workshops to guide the students to crack UGC CSIR NET.
- ➤ Suggestion has also been given regarding designing the bridge course for the students of B.Com. 1st year to connect the basic concepts of eleventh & twelth class with the concepts of Business Mathematics
- ➤ It was also suggested that number of lectures per week in B.Sc. I.T. 1st year & B.C.A. 1st year should be increased so as to complete the syllabus, revision & doubt session in time.

Department of English:

- > It was found that few contents in the first year are outdated and that may be replaced by new topics.
- > It was also suggested that a more advanced topic should be added to the syllabus where focus should be more on spoken English and communication skills to enhance their language skills.

Department of Hindi:

- > In B.A. First Year textbook "Madhyakal is Kavya Kunj", the syllabus is too lengthy.
- > It is suggested to modernize the curriculum of Second Year.
- > Communication skills should be included so that employment opportunities can be made available to the students.
- > Curriculum should be related to grammar and pronunciations.
- > There should be practicality in the curriculum and Moral values should be included in the curriculum.

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Sanatan Dharma College Ambala Cantt Overall Remarks: The feedback received from the Teachers about the current curriculum is overall satisfactory. The suggestions given by the Teachers are considered and sent to IQAC by the concerned Departments. The efforts will be made to fulfill all the suggestions and requirements of the Teachers regarding curriculum so that students may be benefitted with the additional knowledge regarding the curriculum.

- The Department of Computer Science was recommended to provide knowledge on new Technologies like Python, digital Marketing, Search Engine Optimization Techniques, and Wordpress by organizing workshop, courses and other similar activities.
- As per the requirements and suggestion received from the students, the department of Electronics was recommended that along with the practicals, the python language must be taught so that they may be compatible with the market requirements. Industrial training after each session also to be incorporated as per the demand of the present scenario.
- IT students recommended PHP and Java training course to be covered along with the university curriculum. It was also suggested by the students that subject related more workshops must be conducted so as to more hands-on exposure can be experienced by the students. It was suggested to Electronics Department to make an action plan for the coming session to fulfill these requirements of the students. In addition, institute-level efforts to be made to prepare students for the demands of the market by adding new content in the form of bridge courses and certificate courses.
- ✓ Recommendation was made to all the Departments and Career Guidance Cell to organize the classes for the preparation of competitive Examinations.

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- ✓ The suggestions were imparted to the Faculty of Arts to prepare the students for the market need and action to be taken for the overall enhancement of the students.
- ✓ All the departments were suggested to inform the respective Board of Studies committees about the updation required to uplift the quality of syllabus and overall growth of the students.
