A well structured Action Plan will be made to strengthen these two aspects and action will be implemented as per the suggestions of the faculty in specific subjects.

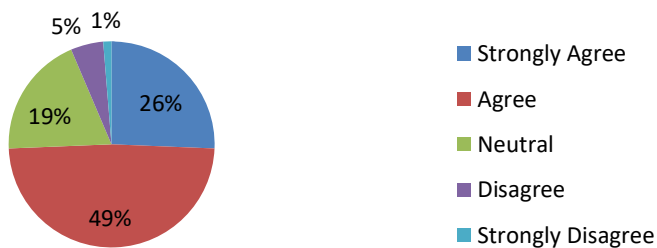



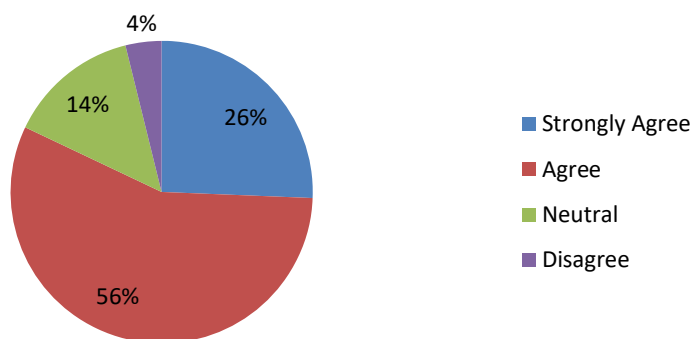

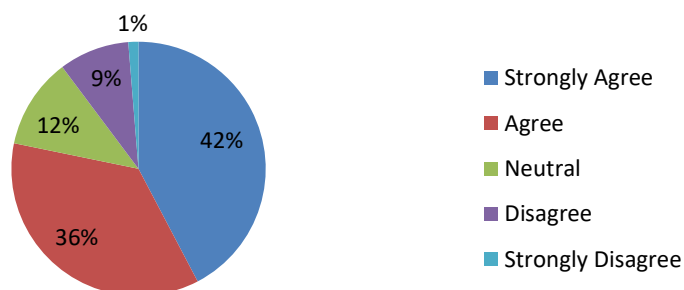

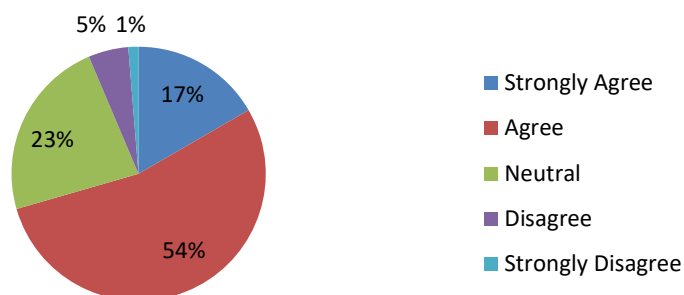

The teachers of the department are satisfied with the curriculum. The syllabus is at par with the other universities.


#### Department of Electronics & IT:





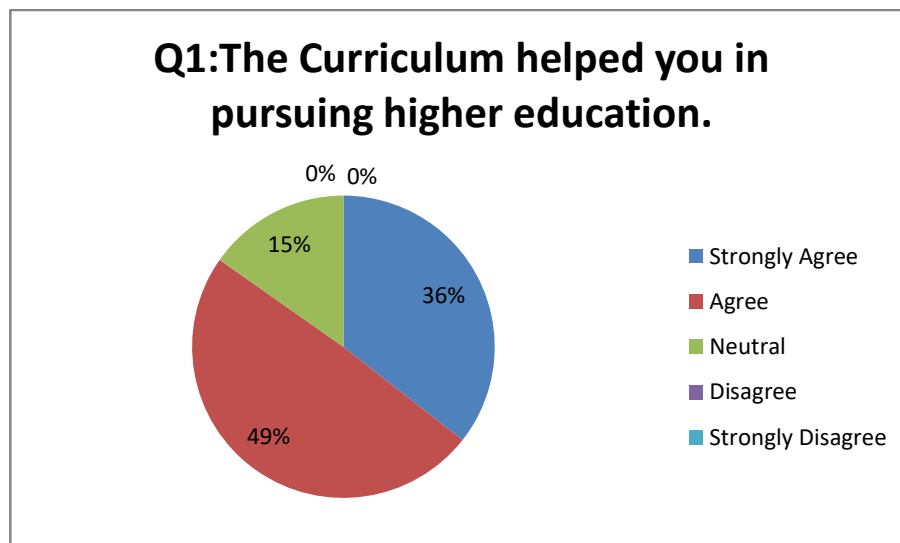
#### Remarks:

- ❖ Response to rest of the parameters is found to be satisfactory and inclined towards agreement. The college will continue with its efforts to make the learning of students more impactful.

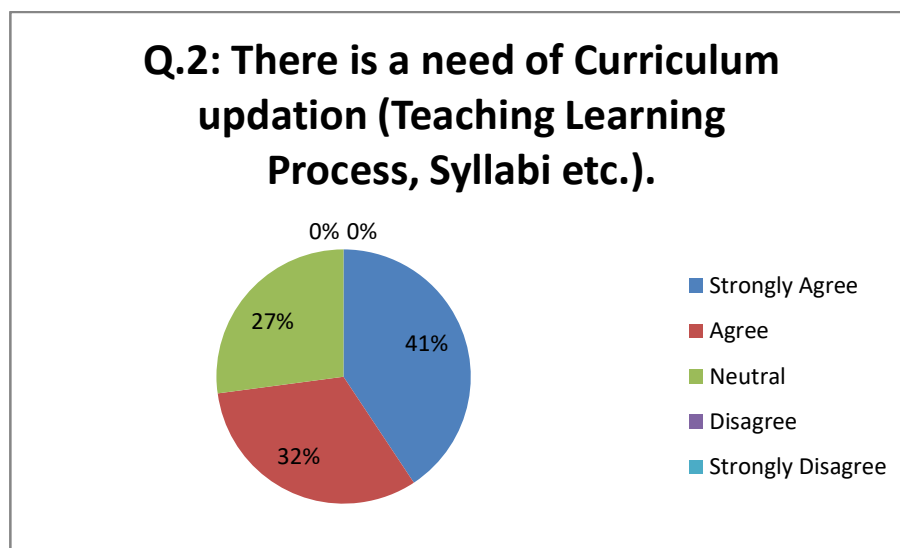


The following are the recommendations as per the suggestions taken from various stakeholders of the Department:

1. The Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) is already implemented in the university campus. It is the urge of all the stakeholders to implement the CBCS in the colleges affiliated to the Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra so that the students may avail the opportunity to choose courses from the prescribed courses comprising core, elective/minor or skill-based courses. It will also benefit the Department to enhance flexibility and impact of the B.Sc (Electronics) programme.
2. It is worth to notify that as the syllabus of B.Sc (Electronics) was revised in 2018-19 for B.Sc-Ist Year. In 2019-20, B.Sc-IIrd Year syllabus was also revised. But B.Sc-IIIrd Electronics syllabus is not yet revised. You are kindly requested to change the Electronics Syllabus for IIIrd Year students also and new technology based subjects must be added in the Syllabus.
3. In Paper-I, B.Sc-III, students still studying 8085 Microprocessor, This must be replaced by updated Microcontrollers so that students can survive in the professional career as per the requirements of the Industry.
4. It was also suggested by the students of B.Sc-IIIrd Year students that instead of C language in Paper-II Electronics, Latest Language must be included in syllabus. Relevant to the practical feasibility w.r.t subject

We hope you will consider these suggestions in the upcoming meeting of UGBoS and will take the necessary actions.


