






Remarks: From the responses received, it has been noticed that 68% of the Arts students are satisfied with their syllabus in terms of load and 6% students showed their disagreement on this point.




Remarks: 84% students fully agreed with objective stated to the course contents. Only 1% disagreement has been noticed.
















Remarks: 63% students are satisfied with the syllabus in terms of load.13 % students disagreed.




Remarks: 87% of the students agreed and 5% disagreed. Proper action will be taken to improve this aspect.

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


Remarks: 72% Science students are satisfied and said that there is proper blend between with the theory and practical syllabi. Only 5% students disagreed.



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


Remarks: 75% students are satisfied with the curriculum on its enrichment in developing interest in the subject area whereas 7% disagreed.




Remarks: 79% science students are satisfied with the internal assessment system provided by the university. 5% disagreed on this aspect.

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


Remarks: 83% students are satisfied with the reading material and availability of their subjects books in Library but 5 % students disagreed.



Remarks: 89% Science students said that there are sufficient opportunities to learn skills and gaining knowledge. No disagreement has been noticed.







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



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




Remarks: 61% students think that the internal assessment system is unbiased and only 9% students want improvement in this.

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



Proper Action plan will be made to strengthen these two parameters so that students may be benefitted at the fullest.


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





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


Remarks: 81% Teachers are satisfied that curriculum is not bulky but 4% Teachers said that curriculum is heavy and necessary action must be taken.



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


Remarks: 86% Teachers are completely satisfied with the internal evaluation system. Only 1% disagreement was observed.



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







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





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




